We have also included a roster for each church. Please have that completed <u>before</u> your arrival. This will save time at check in. If you wish to register in advance, you may e-mail your registration roster early and then bring the original form on the day of the event. Please attach the original roster to a large envelope and enclose your permission slips and, if at all possible, one check made payable to Evangel Baptist Church. We will be making one payment to Whitetail.

We will need total counts by Monday, January 21st. Please let us know how many teens are in your group, how many leaders you are bringing, how many in your group will be tubing for 1 hour, and how many will be tubing for 2 hours. If you have extra people sign up for or cancel after that time, please call or e-mail the office as soon as possible with the changes. Reminder: We have to pay for the tubing tickets in advance! You WILL BE responsible for the cost of ALL OF THE TUBING TICKETS for which you have registered by Wednesday, even if someone from your church does not come or decides they do not want to tube.


